



Cedar Point II Wind Energy Centre Community Benefits Grant Application

The Cedar Point II Wind Energy Centre (Project) is located on privately owned lands located within Lambton County and falls within three municipalities: The Town of Plympton-Wyoming, the Municipality of Lambton Shores and the Township of Warwick, Ontario.

At NextEra Energy Canada, we believe in building strong partnerships and supporting the communities we serve. The Cedar Point II Community Benefits grant process is one way that the project can have a positive impact within our host communities.

The Process

The Cedar Point II Wind Energy Centre is accepting applications for community benefits funding between April 16 and May 18, 2018. In order to qualify for a community benefit grant, organizations must be located within one of the three host communities of the Project. Please see end of this application form for organizations that are not eligible for funding through this process.

To apply for funding, organizations must complete this application form and submit it via email to Cedar-Point-II-Wind@NextEraEnergy.com by 5 p.m. EST on May 18, 2018. The applications will be reviewed by a panel of Cedar Point II employees.

Funding Priorities

We encourage all eligible community-based organizations to apply for community benefits funding, however priority will be given to initiatives or programs that demonstrate the following focus areas:

- **Education:** We will support innovative programs that teach our current and future workforce how to solve problems using unconventional thinking. An educated, prepared workforce supports the talent needs of our companies, the industry and our host communities. We believe an educated community is an engaged community.
- **Environmental stewardship and innovation:** We will support community-based initiatives and activities that demonstrate and promote environmental sustainability in the region.
- **Arts and culture:** We will support events, initiatives and programming that strengthen community identity and expand public capacity to innovate through arts and culture.

Exclusions

There are some organizations and events that are not eligible for funding under the Community Benefits grant process, including the following: political parties or candidates, religious organizations, private schools, professional sports teams, service clubs and fraternal organizations, professional solicitors or third party fundraising, private clubs funded through membership fees, individuals, individual pursuits, activities and events that take place outside of Canada and the U.S.A., research, feasibility studies, debt-reduction campaigns, goodwill advertising, organizations focused on the advocacy of a particular social, religious, moral, political or economic point of view, and memberships.

Please note that there is no obligation on the Cedar Point II Wind Energy Centre to grant any of the funds and the final grant decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Project.
